Many people with visual impairments learn to adapt and frequently become more courageous and determined. Blindness and visual impairments are individual life experiences as diverse as the people themselves. There is not one common cause of visual impairment in Nye's subjects and there is not one common story of perception, struggle or adaptation among them. Photographs and audio interviews let you see and hear them for yourself. Come away knowing that there are many different ways of seeing.
